

## Serving ALL of Rice County In FY2013\*:

Our Domestic Violence program we served **473** adults (primarily women) and **54** children.

Our Sexual Assault Program we served **62** primary victims and **38** secondary victims (friends and family members who sought support).

We provided of supportive listening and intervention 1,176 times.

Through our Safehousing program we assisted 14 women, 1 male and 22 children, for a total of 65 days of shelter. We also made 38 shelter referrals.

The Safeline provided assistance to **637** callers this past year.

Last year we provided 41 presentations to the community and were able to

reach over **1,216** people.

We provided translation services **215** times for clients.

We had over **94** volunteers donate an astounding **6,483** hours to further our mission to end violence.

The mission of HOPE Center is to create zero tolerance for sexual and domestic violence through healing, outreach, prevention and education. Through innovative programming, we offer direct support to victims of violence in Rice County, collaborative support to other organizations that serve victims, and educational support to the entire community.
